Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD) Each year, all schools in Australia participate in the mandated Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on school students with a disability (NCCD). Information is collected about students with disability across Australia in a consistent, reliable and systematic way.

The following student information is required:

- the student's disability category
- the level of adjustment provided

Data is collected when a student's impairment meets the [Disability Discrimination Act 1992](#) (DDA) broad definition of disability, including those with learning difficulties and health and mental health conditions.

This process provides a nationally comparable set of data to inform improved practices within South Australia and nationally and to support the participation of all students with disability in education on the same basis as those without disability.

Have you changed any of your contact details such as phone number, address or emergency contact information?

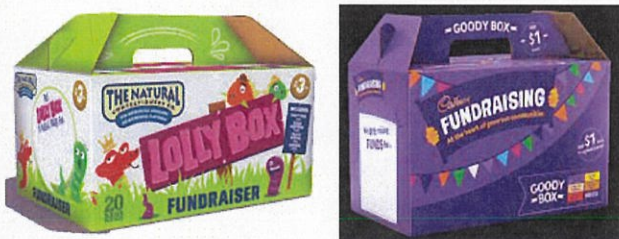
If you have moved, please pop into the Administration office with your new address details so that our system can be updated.
