Dear Parents, Caregivers and Community Members,

It is hard to believe we are halfway through March and so much still to achieve in Term 1. 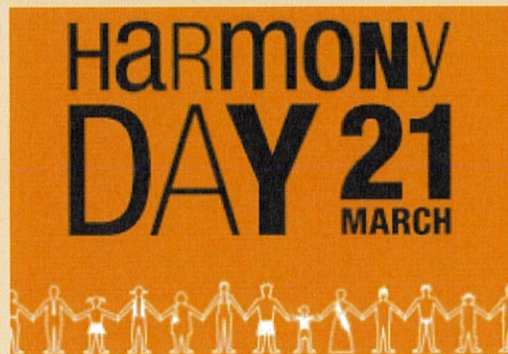

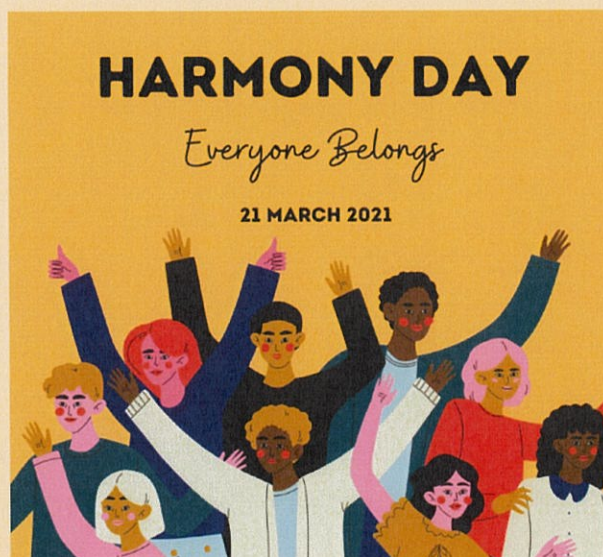


## Wellbeing News

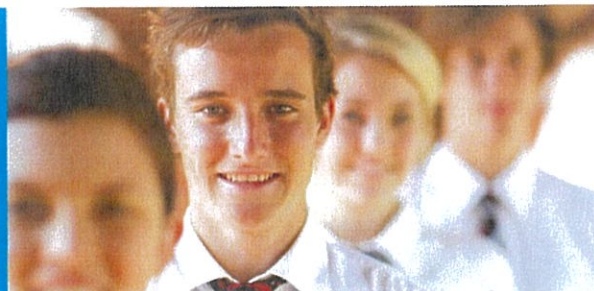
