Before we know it the middle of the year will be here and there are still many things to do before the end of term Our Semester 1 reports will go home on Friday Week 9 and Parent Teacher Interviews will be held in Week 10. Notes inviting you to book a time for these important discussions will go home Monday Week 9, please ensure that you watch out for these and that you book a time to discuss your child's progress with their teacher.

Staff Learning

I would like to take this opportunity to thank our wonderful school community for supporting our staff to take part in a day of learning last Friday. Our learning had varying focuses throughout the day including looking at the new Education Department Strategy for Public Education in South Australia. To put you in the picture the strategy has been developed to cater for a world that is constantly changing and to prepare our children for a future that will be vastly different from today. Our Department has embraced the need to continually adapt to keep up with the changing demands to support our children to learn and thrive beyond the classroom. The strategy has four interrelated areas of impact -: Wellbeing, Equity and Excellence, Learner Agency and Effective Learners. Our work presently is focused on Learner Agency and we spent some time digging deeper into this area as this is also a focus for our School Improvement Plan. We looked at what we already do well and what we can tweak to make a child's experience here at Nicolson even better. It was pleasing to note many links to our Berry Street training from last year and Brightpath, as these are things that we are already working with at our school.

We also explored the new SA Curriculum. Our Department has adapted the Australian Curriculum to suit South Australia and they will be phasing this in in all schools over the next two years.

The SA Curriculum:

- emphasises understanding over recall of information
- outlines dispositions in each learning area that are crucial for effective learning
- includes the general capabilities in each learning areas
- includes Learning Standards that focus on what learners can be, do and understand, demonstrating that dispositions, capabilities and knowledge are valued

The SA Curriculum is presently in prototype and we as teachers can suggest changes to make it work better for our context.

Jane McLean also did a presentation about English as an Additional Language or Dialect which was very informative and certainly raised awareness for many of us about our Aboriginal learners and built our understanding of how best to support these learners.

**Punctuality at School** We have noticed that many of our students have been arriving late each morning and this is having an impact on their learning as they have missed the setup for the day and the recap of what was learnt the day before. If this is your family try to make some tweaks to your routine so that your children are given the best opportunity to access their learning. None of us enjoy the cold starts to the day but it is part of life and we just have to get on with it. **Pam Peters**


